SMFD Welcomes Two New Members to the Team

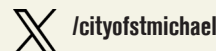
SMFD's Newest Recruits Start this Spring

St. Michael Fire Department's (SMFD) newest recruits – two custom built Pierce fire engines will be responding to emergencies this spring. The engines are ready to roar after almost four-years of detailed planning and construction.

The new engines include upgrades designed to reduce physical strain on firefighters, improve ergonomics, enhance scene visibility, and increase overall operational efficiency when responding to emergency calls.

The new engines join a team of 30 firefighters, three rescue trucks (medical calls/motor vehicle crashes), a tender truck (water transport), grass truck (wildland fire suppression), water rescue boat, and a six-wheeler with trailer (wildland firefighting).

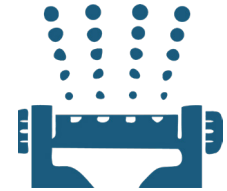

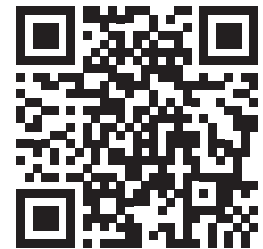

WRIGHT COUNTY HWY 36 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

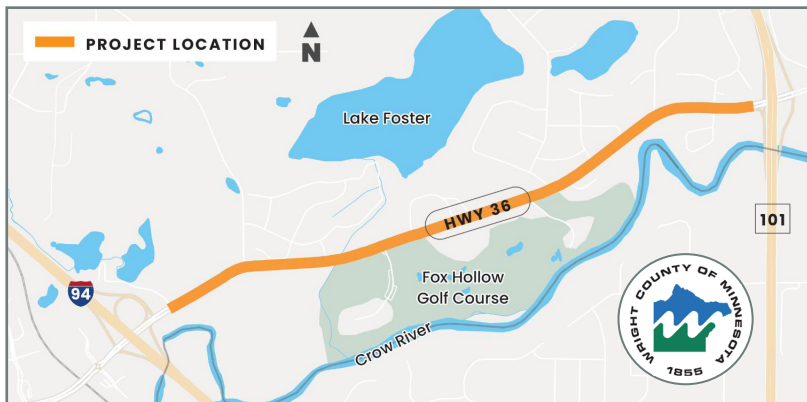
PROJECT UPDATES



Wright County and the City of St. Michael each received federal funds to upgrade the County Hwy 36 corridor. This high-speed, rural roadway is a significant east-west route serving as a direct connection between I-94 on the west and TH 101 on the east.

PROJECT GOALS

- Add a 10-foot wide multi-use trail along the north side of Hwy 36.
- Construct a roundabout at the Ogren Ave. NE intersection.
- Add a continuous center left turn lane to improve safety and access at side streets.



CONSTRUCTION BEGINS SPRING 2026

ANTICIPATED COMPLETION NOVEMBER 2026

NOTE: Westbound CSAH 36 traffic will be detoured via TH101 and I-94 during construction.

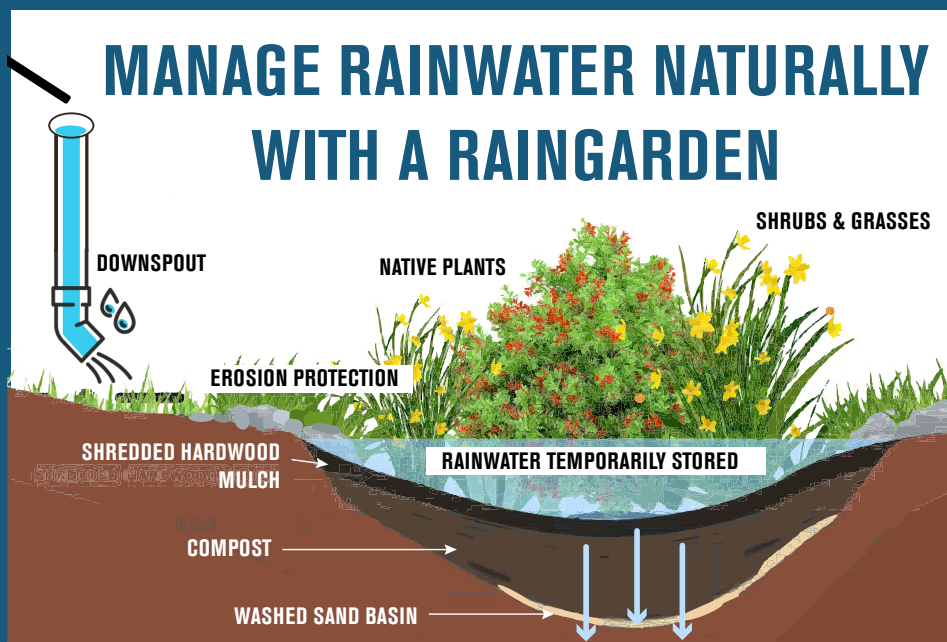
